



Job Title: Gas Safety and Training Specialist **Requisition Number:** 13148BR **Location:** Akron, Ohio

Job Summary:

The Dominion East Ohio Gas Safety & Training Specialist (Akron- Springside facility) will/may:

- 1) Provide advice and coaching to personnel on safety and technical issues;
- 2) Prepare and conduct technical, safety and job skills training and assist with the development and maintenance of training programs and materials;
- 3) Provide safety and technical services to operations personnel;
- 4) Make recommendations for updates to the Accident Prevention Manual, Gas SOPs, Dominion's Operator Qualification Plan and work procedure improvements;
- 5) When appropriate, research governmental regulations and policies and interpret their applicability to gas operations;
- 6) Act as first responder to safety incidents within an assigned area to gather and evaluate accident data;
- 7) Participate in root cause analysis of incidents/accidents and recommend activities to prevent similar accidents/incidents;
- 8) Monitor and evaluate the workplace to ensure compliance with all governmental and company regulations;
- 9) Perform inspections/audits to ensure employees are performing jobs in compliance with regulatory and company safety policies and programs;
- 10) Test and recommend new tools, equipment and work procedures;
- 11) Perform other duties as requested or assigned.

This position will be assigned to the Akron- Springside facility to provide safety (about 35 to 40%) and training (about 60 to 65%) support to the Design and Construction organization, to include job skills training, process/procedure training, operator qualification support, and safety support for employees and contractors. This position #13148 will not provide paid relocation assistance. Valid driver's license is required.

Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities:

Required: Gas industry experience.

Strongly prefer: At least 3 years experience in a related discipline (Gas Delivery Engineering, Design, and Construction processes and procedures).

Other Knowledge, Skills, Abilities and Experiences:

- 1) In-depth knowledge of applicable employee safety and pipeline safety regulations and requirements, including Operator Qualification and Pipeline Integrity Management;
- 2) Thorough understanding of government regulations, company safety policies and approved work methods;
- 3) High level of technical expertise in gas distribution operations;
- 4) Familiar with the field skills, equipment, and technologies used throughout gas distribution system;
- 5) Excellent verbal and written communication, coaching, and computer skills (MS Office to include Excel, PowerPoint and Word);
- 6) Ability to perform root cause analysis on accident/incident investigations;
- 7) Ability to present material in an understandable manner to large and small audiences;
- 8) Ability to train and lead others;
- 9) Ability to process information quickly to develop answers to technical questions
